In June 2023, the Interstate Technology Regulatory Council published Performance-Based Optimization of Pump & Treat Systems. Among other things, the guidance demonstrates the mutually beneficial relationship between optimization, sustainability, and resilience by showing how to integrate these concepts during design, operations, or site closeout. ### Dive In! Revised "Waters of the United States" Definition

On September 8, 2023, the EPA and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers issued a new final rule, Revised Definition of "Waters of the United States," which sets forth Federal permitting requirements for a waterway or wetland that meets the definition of a "water of the United States." The rule was revised to conform with the U.S. Supreme Court's May 25, 2023 ruling in Sackett v. EPA which, among other things, determined that the significant nexus standard was "inconsistent with the text and structure of the [Clean Water Act]." The new rule changes the definition of "adjacent" to "having a continuous surface connection" and eliminates the notion of "interstate wetlands." For more information, click here.



# Did You Know? EPA Clarifies Free Product Removal in UST Regulation

It's been 35 years since 40 CFR 280.64 was promulgated, setting Federal requirements for free product removal from underground storage tanks (USTs). Since its promulgation, much has been learned about how petroleum moves and behaves in subsurface environments. In February 2023, the EPA published UST Technical Compendium: Release Investigation, Confirmation, and Corrective Action. In the communication, the EPA reiterates the objective of 40 CFR 280.64 (i.e., to remove free product to prevent migration) and recognizes that definitions of "free product" have evolved. This recognition is an acknowledgement that not all underground free products are capable of migrating; therefore, the regulation does not require the removal of all measurable free products.
